




One day something happened to the boy's body. His hands became tentacles and he can ink like an octopus.

In my story, octopus tentacles and ink represent evil ideas born of the confusion and discomfort of the time. And the self-disapproval that comes with it. It may come from physical or psychological changes, or the family and so on.

The whole story is about the three processes of suppression, release and balance.

On the one hand, I think the combination of visuals and music can bring a strong effect. On the other hand I want to try the narrative style of the mv.

Music may not be completed for this assignment. I'm still focusing on animation.

VISUAL STYLE


Considering that I might use 2d effects. So a cartoon style look might be my first choice, and there are two options here.
